

## Mpox: Advisory for travellers from at risk countries

Due to the active spread of Mpox in Africa and particularly in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), Rwanda, Uganda, Burundi, the Republic of the Congo, the Central African Republic and Kenya:

→ If you are arriving from one of these areas and you develop a fever and a skin rash with blisters, contact your doctor immediately or a free information, screening and diagnosis center (CeGIDD) to confirm the diagnosis and measures to put in place. If you can contact neither or in case of an emergency, call 15 (National health emergency services).
