mpox circulates actively in Africa and particularly in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), Rwanda, Uganda, Burundi, the Republic of the Congo, the Central African Republic and Kenya

If you are traveling to these areas, follow health precautions

such as regular hand washing and avoiding close contact with people infected with mpox or those who have a skin rash that looks like mpox, with animals infected with mpox (rodents) and with potentially contaminated objects (such as clothing, bedding or tableware used by infected people).

Travel to areas where mpox is actively circulating is not recommended for children, pregnant or breastfeeding women, or immunocompromised persons.
